



## Kardinia International College Scholarship Policy

### 1.0: Rationale

Kardinia International College offers scholarships with the intention of recognising and encouraging students in their pursuit of excellence. The College aims to attract high achieving students and facilitate their successful achievements through the provision of financial support.

### 2.0: Financial

Successful scholarship recipients will be entitled to a reduction in tuition fees, to be determined by the Principal. All financial responsibility for additional charges associated with attending the College will rest with the recipient. Fees including curriculum and foundation levies, enrolment process, sport, buses, uniforms, text books, excursions and camps are not discounted. Current or past families with outstanding fees will be ineligible to receive a scholarship. Fees associated with the scholarship and application process are non-refundable should a student be unsuccessful in being offered a scholarship.

### 3.0: Application Lodgement

To be eligible for a scholarship at Kardinia International College, students must have an **Application for Enrolment** at the College. The Principal will not consider granting a scholarship to applicants that have not satisfactorily completed the application process prior to participating in the Academic and/or Music Scholarship.

### 4.0: Review

Scholarships will be reviewed annually and may be withdrawn at the discretion of the Principal.

### 5.0: Academic Scholarship

#### 5.1 Selection

Academic scholarships are awarded to students on the basis of their performance in an Edutest examination, school reports and an interview with the Principal.

#### 5.2 Eligibility

Academic scholarships are offered at entry to Year 7 only. Academic scholarships will be offered for the duration of the student's enrolment at Kardinia International College.

#### 5.3 Expectations

Successful recipients are expected to maintain high overall academic results, and positively contribute to the College community. Unsatisfactory results or behaviour may result in a scholarship being reviewed.

### 6.0: Music Scholarship

#### 5.1 Selection

Music scholarships are awarded to applicants on the basis of an audition, school reports and an interview with the Principal.

## 5.2 Eligibility

Music scholarships are offered to new and current students in Years 7 to 11. Music scholarships will be offered for the duration of the student's enrolment at Kardinia International College.

## 5.3 Expectations

As a condition of the award, scholarship recipients are required to commit to participating in an instrumental and/or vocal ensemble as deemed appropriate. Scholarship recipients are also expected to participate in all College productions and positively contribute to the College community. Unsatisfactory results or behaviour may result in a scholarship being reviewed.
